

WHO ARE WE ?

The Learning Center is provided by Innovations In Learning, LLC and incorporates the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) to teach social and communication skills to children and adolescents with developmental or learning disabilities. A group setting is used to encourage appropriate social interaction while personal goals and objectives are implemented during individualized instructional activities.

HOW DO YOU KNOW IF YOUR CHILD IS APPROPRIATE?

Your child may be appropriate for the learning center if s/he has difficulty asking for things from the environment, expressing wants or needs, talking about activities completed earlier in the day, or other communication difficulties. Children with communication disorders may also display a high frequency of maladaptive behaviors. They may be resistant to engaging in learning situations or they may have difficulty functioning in a group environment.

WHAT TOOLS DO WE USE ?

The Assessment of Basic Language and Learning Skills (ABLLS) is completed for each child and relevant goals are developed. Each child is provided with a program book, which includes personal objectives for each subscale of the ABLLS, data collection sheets, graphs, and a behavior intervention plan, if necessary.

HOW DO WE TRACK PROGRESS ?

Data is collected on personal and group objectives during each learning session. Probe data is used to determine mastery of identified skills and data is visually represented using graphs. Objectives are regularly updated based on the learning rate of each child. All program changes are empirically based and data driven.

WHAT GROUPS ARE OFFERED?

Group members are designated to personal learning levels:

Early Learners: These learners have significant communication and social deficits. They have difficulty expressing their wants and needs and may have difficulty attending in a learning environment.

Intermediate/Advanced Learners: These learners have the ability to get their wants and needs met using either verbal communication or sign language. They display some advanced skills including identifying items according to a feature, function, or class and may be able to identify some personal information about themselves.

Groups are conducted weekly for 12 weeks.

WHO LEADS THE GROUPS ?

A certified special education teacher, master's level behavior clinicians, and a licensed clinical psychologist are involved in all aspects of the Learning Center.

HOW ARE THE GROUPS FUNDED ?
